WATER SAVING INITIATIVES

- We have a strong borehole and for the last +- 20 years we water the greens, gardens, lawns and fill the swimming pool with borehole water.
- We store the water in 11 x 10000L tanks.
- We have 2 x 2500L tanks on our roof to feed toilets and urinals in the main building.
- Since 2005 we installed waterless urinals, except in 2 areas in the main building.
- Stopped tablecloths in Barn Restaurant.
- Stopped tablecloths and linen napkins in Waterside Restaurant (2016).
- Water saving shower heads have been fitted to all showers (Aug 2017).
- Water jugs for functions are only provided on request (Sept 2017).
- Done away with towels and linen napkins (Oct 2017).
- Changed shower and toilet water in the gym area to filtered borehole water (Oct 2017).
- Water all greens and flower beds only once a week (borehole – 5/1/2018).
- Stop watering all lawn areas (22/1/2018).
- Shower facilities are for KG members only (24/1/2018).
- Limited shower times to 1 ½ minutes (26/1/2018).
- Hope to install hand sanitisers to all basins to enable us to stop water flow to basins (29/1/2017).
- Started a competition amongst staff members to come up with the best water saving initiatives – reward.
